

COVID-19 Business Preparedness Checklist



Use this checklist as a guide for continuing business operations as safely as possible for you, your employees, and the public. Some items may need to be ongoing, so regularly revisit the checklist while COVID-19 cases exist, especially in the event of increased COVID metrics, including hospitalizations and case rates.



Staff Illness

- Create procedures for ill employees
 - ☐ How will you handle exposure with other employees?
 - Will they need to show results of covid testing?
- Implement remote work or teleworking where possible (or other contactless services)
- Communicate these procedures to your staff
- ☐ Implement staff coverage for ill staff
- Notify other staff if there is a need for testing
- Develop a back-up plan for childcare challenges (i.e., quarantined, sick kids, etc.)

Risk Reduction

- Place proper signage to maintain 6 feet distancing and mask procedures
- **□** Develop procedures:
 - To make masks available
 - Order masks
 - Determine what types are acceptable
- Develop procedures for communicating safety measures with staff and patrons
- Develop plan for patrons not willing to abide by safety measures
- Develop protocols for patrons to remove masks (eating) and for communicating effectively

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Outbreak Prep

- Develop a communication plan for notifying staff and patrons
- Ensure proper signage is accessible
- Develop a continuity of operations plan for how you will continue to provide your goods or services
- Develop a plan for quickly pivoting your business back to online, curbside, or outdoor services

Supply Chain



- Develop inventory of what you have
- Develop a plan for disruption of supplies
- Develop list of local and alternative suppliers
- Stockpile personal protective supplies (cleaning, masks)



Definitions

- Confirmed Case of
 COVID-19: Cases of
 COVID-19 that are lab
 confirmed positive
 results of a PCR test
- Probable Case of
 COVID-19: COVID-19-like

 symptomatic individual
 who has had close
 contact with another
 individual with a
 laboratory confirmed
 positive result within the
 past 14 days
- Close Contact: Close and prolonged contact within 6 feet of a cumulative 15 minutes in a 24-hour period
