Executive Summary

In June of 2025, the U.S. Census Bureau released its annual County Business Patterns (CBP) zip code-level by industry economic data. This data series covers most North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) industries (with employees), excluding only agriculture (crop and animal production), rail transportation, Postal Service, sole-proprietorships, public administration, and most establishments reporting government employees. The full release of this data is made available approximately 16 months after the reference year, the most recent of which is 2023. Establishment and employment numbers are from the week of March 12th of 2023.

For this report, Anne Arundel Economic Development Corporation (AAEDC) presented the Census Bureau's establishment numbers by the number of employees and by NAICS industry sectors for Anne Arundel County as a whole. We then looked at the five-year trend for both the number of establishments and the number of employees per industry sector.

Next, we used the zip code-level CBP data to analyze the concentrations of establishments and employees by towns in the County (based on 5-digit Zip Codes) and then presented a breakdown of the number of establishments by industry for each of those towns. Because employment by industry was not available at the zip code-level, establishment and employee data for those zip codes that cross county boundaries were not included in the zip code-level data sets but were included in the countywide numbers.

Broadly, this CBP data is useful for benchmarking and studying the change over time in the number of establishments and employees in a given industry within Anne Arundel County. From a practical standpoint, it is useful to businesses for examining markets and by government for analyzing economic changes over time for administration and planning purposes. At the state and local government level, this data can be used to assess small areas and aid in the development of fiscal policies as well as planning for the future. Noise infusion is added by the Census Bureau to prevent individual businesses from being identified.


Examining the data the County Business Patterns provides for Anne Arundel County, most businesses with employees are small businesses. There are 12,186 establishments with fewer than 20 employees, accounting for 83% of the total employer establishments in the county. The number of establishments with fewer than 50 employees accounts for 94% of the total employer establishments. In addition, the most recent release of non-employer business data puts the number of businesses without employees (such as sole proprietors) at 52,749. Overall, 96.3% of all businesses in Anne Arundel County are small businesses with fewer than 20 employees.

The top three sectors by number of employer establishments in Anne Arundel County are Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services; Retail Trade; and Construction, whereas the top three sectors by employment are Accommodation and Food Services; Retail Trade; and Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services. Examining the last five years of data available (2019-2023), we have seen continued growth in the total number of employer establishments in Anne Arundel County. In 2023, losses in the Finance and Insurance; Transportation and Warehousing; and Administrative and Support industry sectors have been counter-balanced by growth in the Health Care and Social Assistance; Other Services; Construction; Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services; Retail Trade; and Accommodation and Food Services industry sectors. That said, in 2023, growth in total employment for all sectors combined had not reached the early 2020 peak in employment just prior to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Annapolis, Glen Burnie, Pasadena, and Hanover are the top four concentrations of employer establishments in Anne Arundel County.




